Tag Team Rules of Play:

- 1. Teams are 2-players. Teams check in at TD stand after registration for seating assignment.
- 2. Teams play as individuals, at separate tables, through the first eight (8) levels.
- 3. If a teammate goes bust during the registration period (first 8 levels of play) they have the option to re-enter for \$125.
- 4. At the start of Level 9 team's chips are combined into one (1) stack. Players will then tag out and alternate play at every level change.
- *If your teammate goes bust before Level 9 and does not re-enter your team will play on the single remaining chip stack and continue to tag out at each level.
- 5. Players must wear their wristbands at all times during play.
- 6. Players may only play on one team and may not change teams at any

- 7. One player per hand rule enforced at all times.
- 8. There will be a 10-minute break after Level 4.
- 9. \$125 buy-in per player (\$100 prize pool + \$25 administration fee). Administration fee includes any and all staffing/dealer fees, and rake. Players will start with 10,000 in tournament chips.

Rules of Big Blind Ante

- 1. A single ante will be posted by the player in the Big Blind position only.
- 2. In the event the player in the Big Blind has less than the required amount to post both the Big Blind and the Ante, the Big Blind will be posted first, the Ante will be posted second.
- 3. The Ante is dead money. All players may win the entire ante regardless of chip stack
- 4. When the Final Table reaches four-handed play, the Ante amount will be reduced to the equivalent of the Small
